





## Thing to look at:

- Wilted plant
- White/grey rough texture, principally on stems
- Generally closer to the ground

## What to do:

- Spray alcohol on the stem
- With a clean knife, scrap off, and take the sclerotium out (little black balls)
- Put scrap in a bag and throw in in the garbage
- Put a red tape on the string of the plant to identify it.
- Verify everyday, for 4 days, that the disease don't spread

**Important:** every sclerotinium must be removed, otherwise the plant will die. You can take out up to  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the stem thickness without affecting the plant too much.
